The Althea Kraker Memorial Trust Fund was originally established as the Althea Kraker Music Scholarship Fund. The scholarship was created to honor the memory of Althea, a 1973 Gouverneur High School graduate and 1977 Cornell graduate who tragically passed away in June of 1981 at age 25. Althea was the daughter of James Lewis Kraker and Dorothy Laidlaw Dodds. Her dedication to music initiated this fund but additionally her love of sports, family, friends, and community service touched everyone who knew Althea.
